Park River Snag & Clear Assessment Hearing—Zach Herrmann, HEI have a presentation on the planned Phase 6 of the snag & clear of the Park River. This phase will focus on assessing only the south and middle branches and working up those branches. The area to be cleared will be droned before and after to identify areas of concern and cleanup. This assessment would be approximately \$40,500 and could complete 4 river miles. There is state cost share secured for this phase which would match the \$40,500 in assessment. If the assessment is approved by both the WRD and WCC, then bids would be solicited and work would begin in late fall or winter of 2020. Motion to approve 2020 assessment for Park River Snag & Clear by Chairman Campbell, 2nd by Vice Chairman Tanke and passed with a roll call vote of: Campbell -yes, Tanke-yes and Jallo-yes.
