

**BUDGET/SPECIAL MEETING
WALSH COUNTY COMMISSION**

October 10, 2022 – 8:30 a.m.

The Commissioners met for budget purposes only.

Members present: Chairman Skorheim, Commissioners Anderson, Barta, Burianek and Brintnell.

The meeting was called to order and the Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Kris Molde, Auditor, explained that there were some formula errors and a beginning balance error. Once they were corrected the county general fund was within the 60-mill maximum. The mills came in at 59.70 mills.

Commissioners had a lengthy discussion about revenue, maximum mills, approving budget requests without knowing the cost, where we can cut in county general, future of county general, when legislators rolled several funds into county general and set limit at 60 mills, spending down budget at end of year and setting up and using the capital projects funds for the new jail. **Motion by Barta to approve the budget as presented with County General mills at 59.70 mills, senior citizens dropped to zero, veterans service up to 1.5 mills, county agent up to 2 mills and JDA up to 4 mills for a total of 123.70 mills.** Second by Skorheim. Upon roll call all vote yes, motion carried.
